The Subcommittee is directed to evaluate and prepare recommendations regarding the Department of Justice investigation needs, including, but not limited to the need for additional Department of Justice crime investigative staff, crime laboratory analysts and the adequacy of current analyst compensation levels.

The Subcommittee is directed to report its findings and recommendations to the Assembly Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety by June 20, 1985, or sooner.
