Enclosed are two copies of the first biennial report prepared by the Department of Administration, Division of State Energy and Coastal Management, dealing with the energy problems of low income people. Wis. Stats. 16.95(9) requires submission of the report to you by September 1 of even numbered years; you then submit it to the appropriate standing committee. The Department of Health and Social Services, the Public Service Commission, and a fifteen member advisory committee composed of advocates for low income people developed the report. The report identifies progress to date, barriers to solving the energy problems of low income people, and recommendations. Before five and ten year goals can be developed, the contributors to the report must find and assemble much more data in order to identify problems more precisely. The Low Income Advisory Committee will continue to provide direction and advice to the Department regarding solutions to the energy problems of low income people.
