Senate Bill 9. November 1987 Special Session

Relating to the Wisconsin retirement system, fixed retirement investment trusts and transferring funds, limiting property tax levies and state and local expenditures, and dispute settlement procedure in local

government employment. (Vetoed by the governor on May 27, 1988.)

This reconvening of the November 1987 Special Session does not preclude the reconvening of further sessions to take action on other gubernatorial vetoes if necessary.

Adopted by the Joint Committee on Legislative Organization 6-3.

Representative Medinger moved that the assembly stand adjourned until 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, June 7.
