1989 WISCONSIN ACT 247

AN ACT to create 144.375 (5m) of the statutes, relating to: regulation of emissions into the air from coal-powered car ferries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 144.375 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

144.375 (5m) LIMITATION ON IMPOSITION OF EMISSION

STANDARDS. The department may not impose emission standards on a coal-powered car ferry that was manufactured before 1954 and has operated only on Lake Michigan if the coal-powered car ferry does not burn coal with a higher sulfur content than the coal burned before the effective date of this subsection [revisor inserts date].
