EXECUTIVE COMMUNICATIONS

Executive Order Number 72

I, Tommy G. Thompson, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, section 11 and Article V, Section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend

Executive Orders #67 (dated 9/29/89) and #70 (dated 10/10/89), which required the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison on Tuesday, October 10, 1989 at 10:00 a.m., by adding to its business consideration and action upon the following specific legislative business:

To enact legislation relating to expanding the farmland tax credit to include improvements, increasing the maximum credit and making appropriations.

In testimony whereof, I have set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this sixth day of November in the year one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine.
