1991 WISCONSIN ACT 30

AN ACT relating to fire department dues distribution and providing for a study.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions. (1) FIRE DEPARTMENT DUES DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS. Except when applied to 1st class cities, the conditions under section 101.575 (4) (a) of the statutes that relate to compliance with section 101.14 (2) of the statutes and that must be satisfied before the department of industry, labor and human relations may pay any annual fire department dues to a city, village, town or fire department shall not apply to fire department dues collected and paid out for 1990, 1991 and 1992.

(2) LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY. The legislative council shall study the fire prevention inspection requirements in section 101.14 of the statutes and the distribution of fire department dues under sections 101.573 and 101.575 of the statutes, and recommend any needed changes to improve the programs operated under those statutes. The legislative council shall include one or more representatives from a statewide association of fire chiefs in this state on any committee established under this subsection. The legislative council shall report the results of its study and its recommendations to the chief clerk of each house of the 1991 legislature for distribution in the manner provided under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes, no later than February 1, 1992.
