To the Honorable the Legislature:

Wisconsin Act 122 of 1989 made funds available to the Department of Public Instruction (D.P.I.) to enable and

encourage public schools to develop comprehensive programs to prevent or ameliorate alcohol and other drug abuse (AODA) among minors. The Act created, or expanded, funding for seven grant programs.

The department was required to collect and analyze information about the programs funded through the Act and to evaluate their effectiveness.
