GOVERNOR'S VETO MESSAGE

March 30, 1994

To the Honorable Members of the Assembly:

I am vetoing **Assembly Bill 319**, which would repeal the bulk sale provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code, in its entirety.

The bulk sale provisions are a fair business requirement of providing notice to creditors. The bulk sale provisions offer a level of safety, especially for small businesses, ensuring information in a timely manner about a debtor business that decides to sell its assets. Additionally, it does not appear that the required filing of notices impedes business transactions. Therefore, this legislation is unnecessary.
