To the Honorable the Legislature:

1991 Wisconsin Act 39 included the following provision:

SECTION 9145. Nonstatutory provisions; public instruction.

(7f) COMPULSORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE; STUDY. The state superintendent of public instruction and the state director of vocational, technical and adult education shall jointly analyze and evaluate the educational and fiscal effects of the changes made to the compulsory school attendance law under section 118.15 of the statutes of this act, and shall report their findings and recommendations to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature, for distribution in the manner provided under section 13.172(2) of the statutes by January 1, 1994.
