



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1044**

May 7, 1996 - Offered by Representatives UNDERHEIM, ALBERS, WOOD, BALDUS,  
MEYER, BRANCEL and ZIEGELBAUER.

- 1           At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2           **1.** Page 1, line 8: after the first “plan” insert “through a premium reduction”.
- 3           **2.** Page 2, line 5: after “increase” insert “; premium reduction”.
- 4           **3.** Page 2, line 9: after “*increase*” insert “; *premium reduction*”.
- 5           **4.** Page 2, line 10: delete “619.14 (5) (am)” and substitute “619.167”.
- 6           **5.** Page 3, line 22: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
page 4, line 4.
- 7           **6.** Page 4, line 11: after that line insert:
- 8           “SECTION 15m. 619.167 of the statutes is created to read:
- 9           **619.167 Reductions in premiums for other eligible persons.** (1) The
- 10          board may use the moneys appropriated under s. 20.145 (7) (b) to reduce premiums
- 11          during the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 1996, for eligible persons who do not
- 12          receive a premium subsidy under s. 619.165, who have a household income, as

1 defined in s. 71.52 (5), that is less than \$40,000 and who apply to the board for a  
2 reduction in their premium.

3 (2) If the board reduces premiums under sub. (1), the board shall direct the  
4 administering carrier to collect, under s. 619.16 (3) (b), from the eligible persons  
5 under sub. (1) the premiums as reduced under sub. (1) rather than the premiums  
6 established by the commissioner.

7 (3) The commissioner shall forward to the board moneys appropriated under  
8 s. 20.145 (7) (b) in an amount sufficient to pay for any premium reductions under sub.  
9 (1).”
