



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1069**

March 27, 1996 – Offered by Representatives SCHNEIDER and BRANDEMUEHL.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 7: before “and” insert: “, veterans honorary medal decals”.

3 **2.** Page 8, line 24: after that line insert:

4 **“SECTION 20m.** 341.142 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **341.142 Veterans honorary medal decals.** If any person who is registering
6 or has registered a vehicle specified in s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 1. submits a statement from
7 the U.S. department of veterans affairs certifying to the department that the person
8 has been awarded a medal authorized under an act of congress relating to that
9 person’s service in the U.S. armed forces, as defined in s. 40.02 (57m), the department
10 shall, free of charge, procure, issue and deliver to that veteran one decal, similar in
11 appearance to the medal awarded to that veteran, for each motor vehicle registered
12 in the name of that veteran. Notwithstanding s. 341.61 (3), a decal issued under this
13 section shall be displayed in the manner directed by the department on the rear
14 registration plate of the vehicle registered in the name of the veteran to whom the
15 decal was issued. The department shall specify one combination of colors and design
16 for each medal authorized under an act of congress for which a statement has been

1 received by the department under this section, except that the department may not
2 specify the colors or design unless the colors and design are approved in writing by
3 the state department of veterans affairs. Not more than one decal may be issued
4 under this section for each motor vehicle registered in the name of a veteran.”.
