



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 9,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 69**

September 28, 1995 – Offered by Representative URBAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 6: delete lines 6 to 19 and substitute:

3 “(4) (a) Nothing in this section prohibits a political subdivision from continuing
4 to enforce an ordinance or resolution that is in effect on the effective date of this
5 paragraph [revisor inserts date], and that regulates the sale, purchase, purchase
6 delay, transfer, ownership, use, keeping, possession, bearing, transportation,
7 licensing, permitting, registration or taxation of any firearm up until the date of the
8 next spring or general election that is held not less than 45 days after the effective
9 date of this paragraph [revisor inserts date], except that, if the existing ordinance
10 or resolution is approved in a referendum that is held in the political subdivision at
11 that next spring or general election, the political subdivision may continue to enforce
12 the ordinance or resolution after the date of the election. The ballot question shall
13 be “Shall the [name of political subdivision] continue to enforce the [ordinance or
14 resolution] which does the following: “[text or summary of the ordinance or
15 resolution]?””
