



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 954**

March 14, 1996 - Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 7: after "vehicles" insert: ", allowing a motor vehicle lessee to
3 reserve the right to continued use of a personalized registration plate".

4 **2.** Page 15, line 11: after that line insert:

5 "SECTION 47m. 341.145 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 341.145 (4) Each personalized registration plate issued shall be reserved for
7 the recipient or, in the case of a leased vehicle, for the lessee in succeeding
8 registration periods and shall not be duplicated for issuance to any other person if
9 the recipient or lessee maintains the plate, unless the recipient or, in the case of a
10 leased vehicle, the lessee authorizes the issuance of the plate to another person. If
11 the recipient or, in the case of a leased vehicle, the lessee does not maintain the plate
12 for 2 successive years which are not plate issuance years or if the recipient or lessee
13 does not specifically request reissuance of the personalized registration plate by the
14 end of the month in which the plate expires in a plate issuance year, the department
15 may issue the personalized registration plate to another applicant. Registration

1 ~~plate numbers issued as special numbers prior to January 1, 1979, will be reserved~~
2 ~~for issuance as personalized registration plates in the same manner as prescribed for~~
3 ~~personalized registration plates in this section.”.~~
