

## ENROLLED JOINT RESOLUTION

---

**Relating to** the life and public service of Elmer C. Peterson.

Whereas, Elmer C. Peterson was born in Martin County, Minnesota, on November 30, 1892, and died on June 19, 1978; and

Whereas, he was educated in the public schools of Rockford, Illinois, and at Brown's Business College; and

Whereas, he served with the U.S. Army in a mortar battery unit during World War I; and

Whereas, he served as a town clerk, a school clerk, a town chairperson and a member of a county board; and

Whereas, Mr. Peterson was the president of the Douglas County Farmers Union from 1931 to 1938; and

Whereas, he served in the assembly from 1931 to 1938 and in the senate from 1943 to 1944; and

Whereas, he held public office continuously from 1926 to 1944; now, therefore, be it

*Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That* the members of the legislature of the state of Wisconsin salute Elmer C. Peterson's many devoted years of public service and express their sorrow at his death.
