



## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 649

October 27, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER, ROBSON, GRONEMUS, BOCK, NOTESTEIN, RILEY, WIRCH, R. YOUNG, MUSSER, GOETSCH, PLACHE, PLOMBON, KREUSER and BOYLE, cosponsored by Senator BURKE. Referred to Joint committee on Information Policy.

1     **AN ACT to create** 628.385 of the statutes; **relating to:** disclosure of identifying  
2     information.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires an insurance agent to disclose to any person who applies for insurance, both orally and in writing, any information that identifies the person that the agent has provided to or received from a national or statewide data base. The bill also requires an insurer to disclose to each insured under each policy issued by the insurer, in writing annually or at renewal if renewal is on an annual basis or more often, any information that identifies the insured that the insurer has provided to or received from a national or statewide data base.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3     **SECTION 1.** 628.385 of the statutes is created to read:  
4     **628.385 Disclosure of identifying information required.** (1) An  
5     intermediary shall disclose to an applicant for insurance any identifying information  
6     about the applicant that the intermediary has provided to or received from a national  
7     or statewide data base. The disclosure required under this subsection shall be  
8     provided both orally and in writing at the time of application, regardless of whether  
9     insurance coverage is provided or denied to the applicant.
