



## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 910

February 21, 1996 - Introduced by Representatives KELSO, OLSEN, UNDERHEIM, JENSEN, LADWIG, SKINDRUD and HAHN, cosponsored by Senator DRZEWIECKI. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT to create** 118.325 of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing the search of  
2             a pupil's locker.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill authorizes a school official, employe or agent to search a pupil's locker for any reason, at any time, without the consent of the pupil, without notifying the pupil and without obtaining a search warrant if the school board has adopted a written policy specifying that the school board retains ownership and possessory control of all pupil lockers and has distributed a copy of the policy to each pupil enrolled in the school district.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 118.325 of the statutes is created to read:

4             **118.325 Locker searches.** An official, employe or agent of a school or school  
5             district may search a pupil's locker for any reason, at any time, without the consent  
6             of the pupil, without notifying the pupil and without obtaining a search warrant if  
7             the school board has adopted a written policy specifying that the school board retains  
8             ownership and possessory control of all pupil lockers and has distributed a copy of  
9             the policy to each pupil enrolled in the school district.
