



1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 101

May 7, 1996 - Introduced by COMMITTEE ON ASSEMBLY ORGANIZATION, by request of Representative Dobyms and Senator Zien. Referred to Calendar.

1 **Relating to:** proclaiming “Law Enforcement Week” and “Law Enforcement
2 Memorial Day”.

3 Whereas, law enforcement officials throughout the state of Wisconsin place
4 themselves in imminent danger on a daily basis to protect and serve the citizens of
5 this great state; and

6 Whereas, this service to the public often requires law enforcement officers to
7 give more consideration to the safety of the public than to themselves; and

8 Whereas, we honor the men and women who serve this state as law enforcement
9 officers and acknowledge and appreciate the difficult nature of their responsibilities;
10 and

11 Whereas, we thank, express our appreciation and pay tribute to our dedicated
12 law enforcement officers who have accepted the risks implicit in their profession and
13 the critical nature of the duties and services they render; and

14 Whereas, it is important and appropriate that we pause to remember those who
15 have fallen in the line of duty; now, therefore, be it

16 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the
17 legislature of the state of Wisconsin proclaim May 12 to May 18, 1996, “Law

1 Enforcement Week”, proclaim May 15 “Law Enforcement Memorial Day” and
2 encourage the citizens of Wisconsin to join in the capitol remembrance ceremony on
3 May 17 at 12:00 noon at the Capitol’s north entrance.
