2             Whereas, May is recognized throughout the United States as "Older Americans

7     Governor's Conference on Aging on March 7, 1995, for over 500 attendees from

11    Conference; and

12            Whereas, the Governor's Conference on Aging honored and supported senior  
13    citizens by creating an atmosphere in which health, long-term care, housing,  
14    transportation, personal safety and economic security issues were addressed; and
