



1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 79

January 29, 1996 – Introduced by Representative SERATTI, cosponsored by Senator FITZGERALD. Referred to Calendar.

1 **Relating to:** proclaiming Economic Development Partnership Week.

2 Whereas, pride, productivity and a dynamic partnership between the public
3 and private sectors are important resources for economic development in Wisconsin;
4 and

5 Whereas, more than 525,000 jobs have been created in Wisconsin since late
6 1985 and jobs continue to be created in the state at one and one-half times the
7 national average; and

8 Whereas, the unemployment rate in Wisconsin has been below the national
9 average for 90 consecutive months and the state consistently ranks among the
10 nation's 10 top states in employment statistics; and

11 Whereas, personal income of the citizens of Wisconsin grew twice as fast as
12 inflation in 1994, which was the 10th highest in the nation; and

13 Whereas, Wisconsin's favorable business climate, outstanding quality of life,
14 abundant natural resources and well-developed infrastructure make the state an
15 attractive place for business growth; and

16 Whereas, local officials, business and industry leaders, economic development
17 professionals, educators and other people promoting Wisconsin and its communities

1 continue to seek innovative ways to work together to build a strong and healthy state;
2 now, therefore, be it

3 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the
4 legislature of the state of Wisconsin recognize February 12 to 17, 1996, as “Economic
5 Development Partnership Week” in the state of Wisconsin.
