



1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 89

March 14, 1996 - Introduced by Representatives DUEHOLM, HUBLER and BOYLE, cosponsored by Senators CLAUSING and JAUCH. Referred to Calendar.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Eugene Taylor.

2 Whereas, Eugene Taylor was born on February 26, 1931, in Spooner, and died
3 January 14, 1996, in Spooner; and

4 Whereas, Mr. Taylor served in the U.S. navy for 4 years during the Korean War;
5 and

6 Whereas, Mr. Taylor served as the St. Croix Tribal Chairman for 24 years; and

7 Whereas, he was active in a number of civic organizations, including the Siren
8 VFW and the Burnett County Historical Society, and he founded the St. Croix/Hertel
9 Fire Department; and

10 Whereas, Mr. Taylor was the chairman of the Great Lakes Tribal Council
11 during its early years; now, therefore, be it

12 **Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That** the members of the
13 Wisconsin legislature commend Eugene Taylor's many years of public service,
14 express their sorrow at his death and extend their condolences to his family and
15 friends; and, be it further

16 **Resolved, That** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
17 resolution to Mr. Taylor's wife, Dorothy, and to his children: Donald Taylor, Joseph
