



1995 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 15

January 30, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives LORGE and GOETSCH. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1 **To create** assembly rule 98; **relating to:** written adjournment remarks.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution permits a member of the assembly to file written adjournment remarks for inclusion in the journal. The remarks may not exceed 50 words and must be included in the journal without change.

2 **Resolved by the assembly, That:**

3 **SECTION 1.** Assembly rule 98 is created to read:

4 Assembly Rule 98. **Written adjournment remarks.** (1) Any member may
5 file with the chief clerk for inclusion in the journal, without obtaining the floor or
6 using a microphone, his or her written remarks made in conjunction with adjourning
7 the assembly in honor of a person or organization or to introduce an individual or
8 group or mention that an individual or group had visited the capital city.

9 (2) The written remarks may not exceed 50 words. The chief clerk shall include
10 the written remarks in the journal without change.
