1 **To amend** assembly rule 39 (1); **relating to:** prohibiting the offering of assembly

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution prohibits a member or standing committee of the assembly from offering a proposal memorializing congress.

3	Resolved by the assembly, That:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Assembly rule 39 (1) is amended to read:
5	Assembly Rule 39 (1) Except as otherwise provided in joint rule 83 (2), any
6	member or standing committee may offer proposals for introduction in the assembly
7	on any day of the biennial legislative session, except that a member or standing
8	committee may not offer a proposal memorializing congress.
