



1995 SENATE BILL 136

April 6, 1995 - Introduced by Senators DARLING and BURKE, cosponsored by Representatives WASSERMAN, LA FAVE, BOCK and ZIEGELBAUER. Referred to Committee on Transportation, Agriculture and Local Affairs.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** repaving a portion of I 43 in Milwaukee County.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the department of transportation to repave a portion of I 43 in Milwaukee County to eliminate the tined surface.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; transportation.**

3 (1) The department of transportation shall repave that portion of I 43 with a
4 tined surface beginning before Henry Clay Street and extending beyond Bender and
5 Devon streets in Milwaukee County, no later than 6 months after the effective date
6 of this subsection, for the purpose of eliminating the tined surface. The department
7 shall expend funds from the appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (cq) or (cx) of the
8 statutes for the repaving project.
