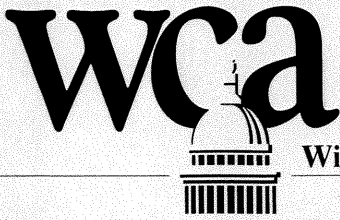

RE: Senate Bill 320 - Dog Damage Claims

The Wisconsin Counties Association (WCA) respectfully requests amending Senate Bill 320 (SB 320) regarding expanding the dog damage claims program.

Counties currently receive revenues from the issuance of dog licenses. After deducting certain expenses, the balance of the licensing revenues, up to \$1,000, is spent on dog damage claims.

Under current law, (ss. 174.11) the owner of a pig, sheep, cow, horse, certain types of fowl, dog, cat or ranch mink may file a dog damage claim with their town, village, or city clerk if their animal has been injured, chased, or killed by a dog. The municipal governing body or appropriate committee must investigate the claim and submit their findings to the county clerk. The clerk reports all claims filed to the county board, where they or a subcommittee examines and if appropriate, pay the claim.

SB 320 would add bison, llamas, alpacas and elk or other deer raised in captivity to the present list of animals for which dog damage claims may be filed.

The bill currently increases the animals covered under the program without a corresponding increase in appropriations. WCA respectfully request amending SB 320 to allocate state dollars for this increase to the dog damage claim program.
