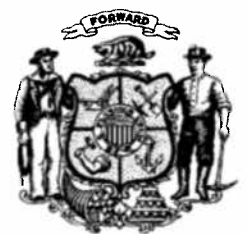



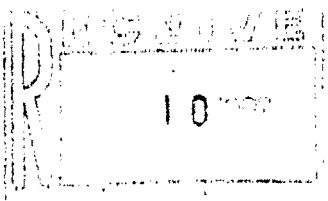

AB 416 authorizes municipal insurance mutuals to add property insurance coverage to its already-authorized risk management services and liability insurance coverage for their members. While the new program would extend the purview of OCI's regulatory functions and examination activities, it is anticipated that current staffing patterns will enable this to be accomplished with no additional fiscal impact on state resources.

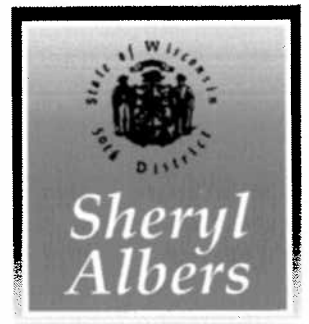
