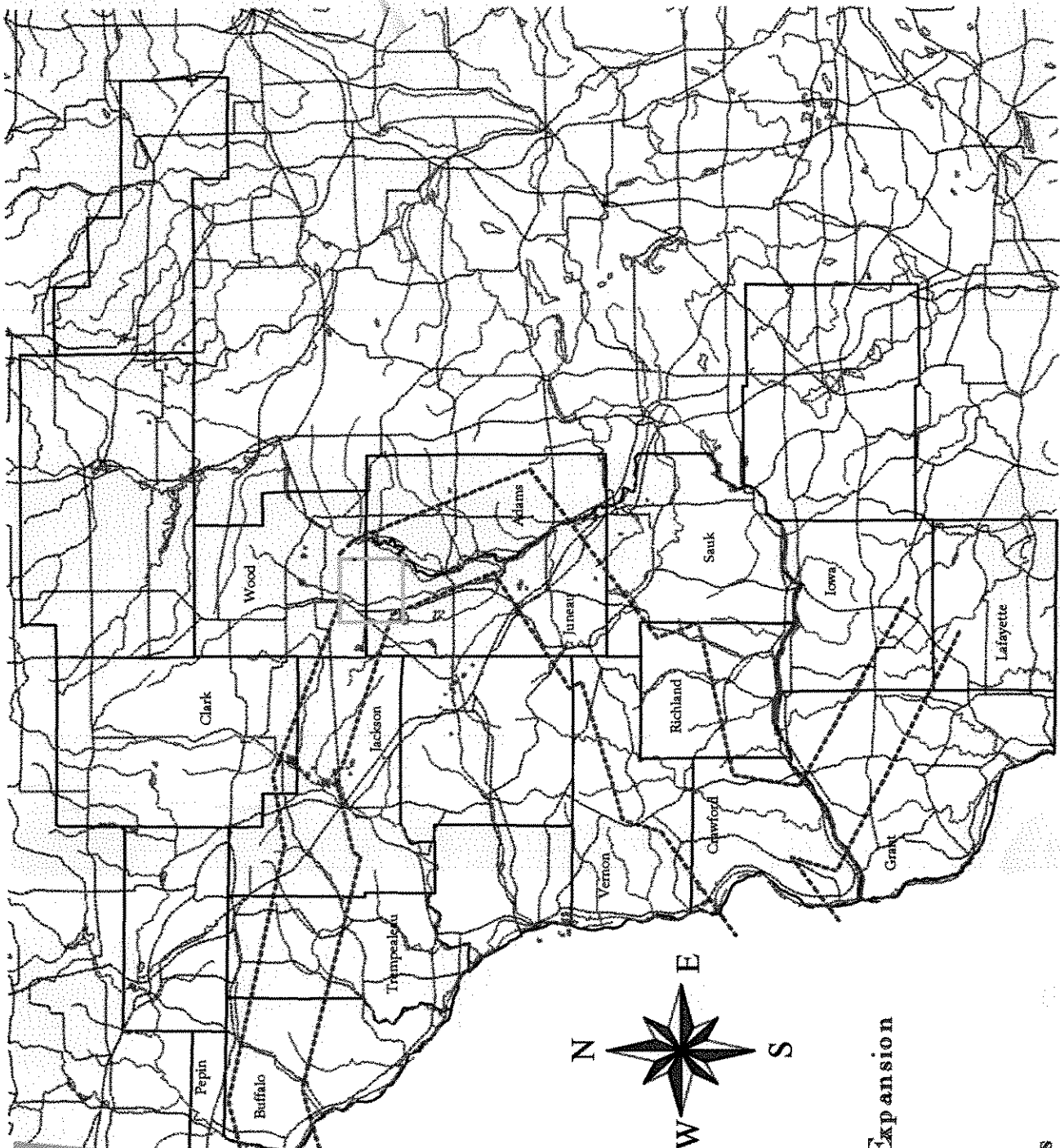

# Proposed Low - Level Flight Corridor

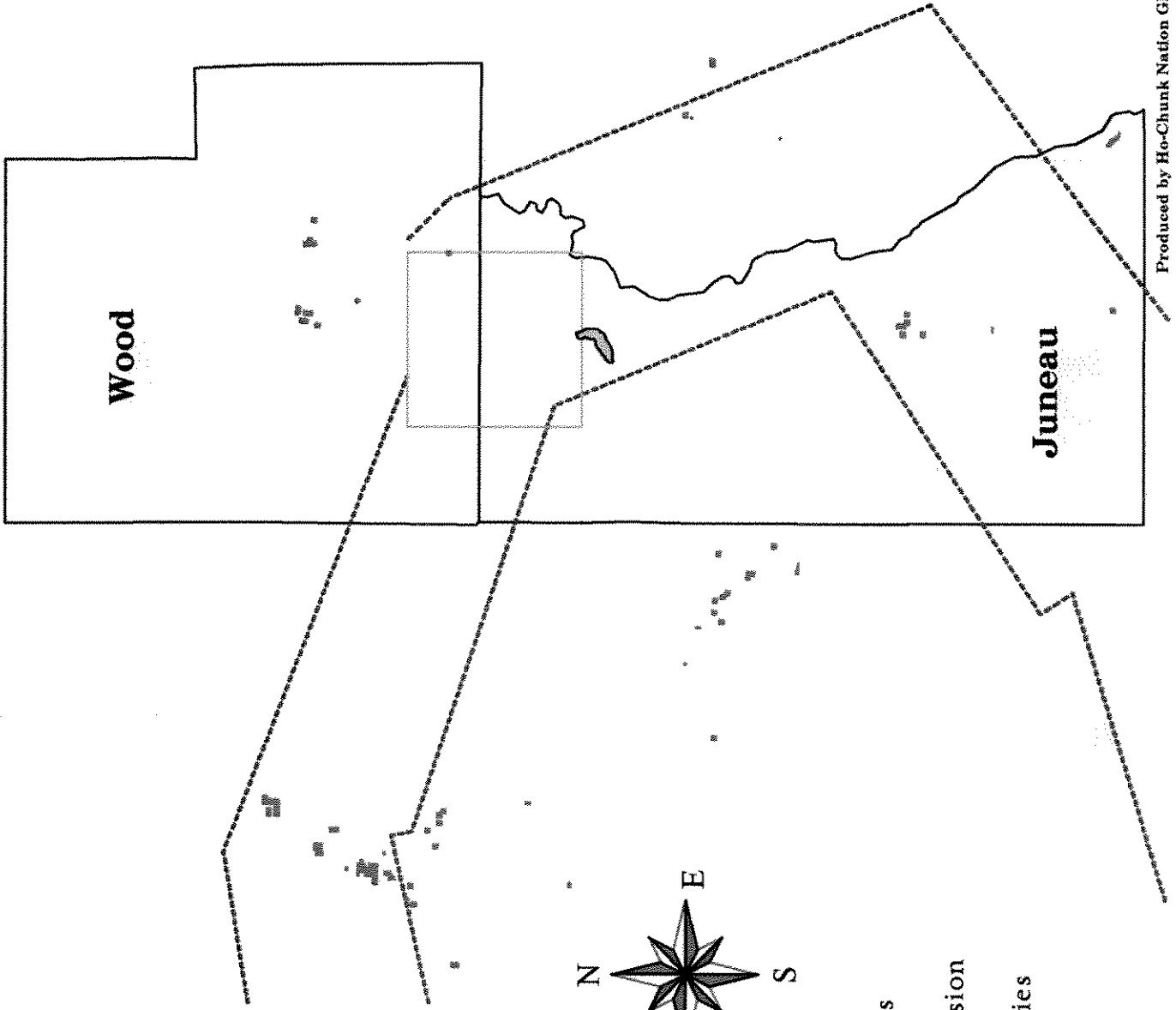

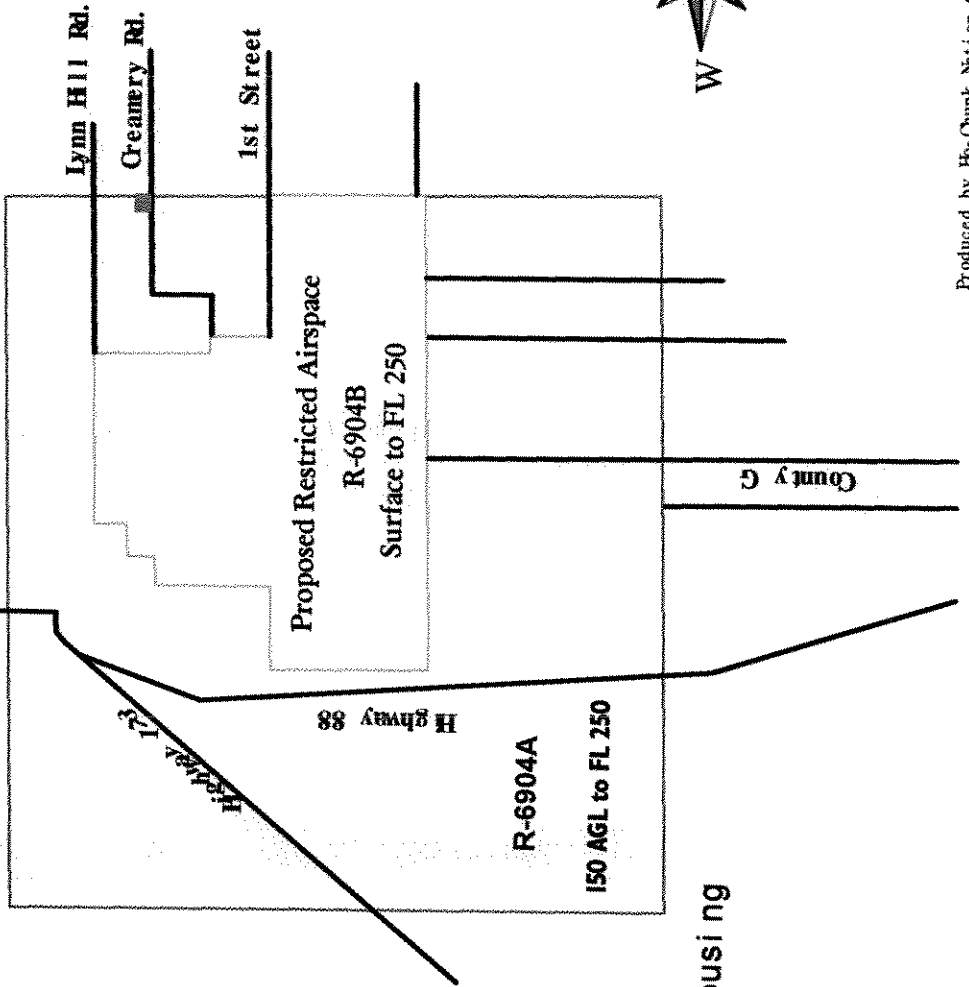
# Archaeological Sites in Flight Corridor
