**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 195**

October 30, 1997 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

1 **AN ACT to create** 767.25 (1m) (gm) and 767.51 (5) (em) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** modifying the amount of child support if a child is 16 or 17 years old and not
3 in school.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 767.25 (1m) (gm) of the statutes is created to read:

5 767.25 (**1m**) (gm) The fact that the child is 16 or 17 years old and not enrolled
6 in a school program or a high school equivalency program, including a home-based
7 private educational program, as defined in s. 115.001 (3g), unless the child has
8 graduated from high school or been granted a declaration of high school equivalency.

9 **SECTION 2.** 767.51 (5) (em) of the statutes is created to read:

10 767.51 (**5**) (em) The fact that the child is 16 or 17 years old and not enrolled in
11 a school program or a high school equivalency program, including a home-based

1 private educational program, as defined in s. 115.001 (3g), unless the child has
2 graduated from high school or been granted a declaration of high school equivalency.

3 **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**

4 (1) This act first applies to temporary orders, final judgments and orders, and
5 revisions of judgments and orders, that are granted on the effective date of this
6 subsection.
