



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 90**

October 23, 1997 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND CORRECTIONS.

1 **AN ACT** *to repeal* 939.74 (2) (d); *to amend* 939.74 (2) (c); and *to create* 939.74
2 (2) (cm) of the statutes; **relating to:** time limits for prosecution of crimes
3 against children.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 939.74 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 939.74 (2) (c) A prosecution for violation of s. 948.02, 948.025, 948.03, ~~948.04~~
6 (2) (a), 948.05, 948.06, 948.07 (1), (2), (3) or (4), 948.08 or 948.095 shall be commenced
7 before the victim reaches the age of ~~26~~ 31 years, or be barred.

8 **SECTION 2.** 939.74 (2) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:
9 939.74 (2) (cm) A prosecution for violation of s. 948.03 (2) (b) or (c), (3) or (4),
10 948.04 or 948.07 (5) or (6) shall be commenced before the victim reaches the age of
11 26 years or be barred.

12 **SECTION 3.** 939.74 (2) (d) of the statutes is repealed.
