**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 SENATE BILL 23**

April 28, 1998 – Offered by Senator DRZEWIECKI.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 341.14 (6r) (b) 1., 341.14 (6r) (b) 3., 341.14 (6r) (c) and 341.14
2 (6r) (e); **to repeal and recreate** 341.14 (6r) (c) and 341.14 (6r) (e); and **to create**
3 16.25, 20.395 (5) (cj), 20.455 (2) (jp), 20.505 (3) (j), 25.40 (1) (a) 13., 165.86 (3),
4 341.14 (6r) (b) 6., 341.14 (6r) (f) 53. and 341.14 (6r) (h) of the statutes; **relating**
5 **to:** special distinguishing registration plates associated with the Green Bay
6 Packers professional football team, payments to D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., Boys
7 and Girls Clubs of America and the Children’s Hospital of Wisconsin, Inc., and
8 making appropriations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

9 **SECTION 1.** 16.25 of the statutes is created to read:
10 **16.25 Contributions from proceeds of special license plates.** The
11 secretary of administration shall make payments in equal amounts from the

1 appropriation under s. 20.505 (3) (j) to the Boys and Girls Club of America and to the
2 Children's Hospitals of Wisconsin, Inc.

3 **SECTION 2.** 20.395 (5) (cj) of the statutes is created to read:

4 20.395 (5) (cj) *Licensing fees, state funds.* From the general fund, all moneys
5 received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6. a. for the purpose of making payments of licensing
6 fees under s. 341.14 (6r) (h).

7 **SECTION 3.** 20.455 (2) (jp) of the statutes is created to read:

8 20.455 (2) (jp) *D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., payments.* All moneys received under
9 s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6. b. 1. for payments to D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., under s. 165.86
10 (3) (a).

11 **SECTION 4.** 20.505 (3) (j) of the statutes is created to read:

12 20.505 (3) (j) *Contributions to charitable organizations.* All moneys received
13 under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6. b. 2. for payments to Boys and Girls Clubs of America and
14 to the Children's Hospital of Wisconsin, Inc. under s. 16.25.

15 **SECTION 5.** 25.40 (1) (a) 13. of the statutes is created to read:

16 25.40 (1) (a) 13. Moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 6. that are deposited
17 in the general fund and credited to the appropriations under ss. 20.395 (5) (cj), 20.455
18 (2) (jp) and 20.505 (3) (j).

19 **SECTION 6.** 165.86 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

20 165.86 (3) (a) Enter into an agreement with D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., to make
21 payments from the appropriation under s. 20.455 (2) (jp) to D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd.,
22 to fund any of the following:

23 1. Programs and activities relating to drug abuse resistance education,
24 including law enforcement training to implement drug abuse resistance education

1 programs in this state and to conduct public educational activities consistent with
2 the purposes of D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd.

3 2. Reasonable costs relating to marketing of the special group plate under s.
4 341.14 (6r) (f) 53. D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., may enter into a marketing agreement
5 with any person to provide the services under this subdivision.

6 (b) The agreement under par. (a) shall require that D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd.,
7 annually submit to the attorney general and the presiding officer of each house of the
8 legislature an audited financial statement of its use of the payments under par. (a),
9 prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

10 (c) Payments to D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., under par. (a) shall be discontinued
11 by the department if D.A.R.E. Wisconsin, Ltd., dissolves or is no longer exempt from
12 taxation under section 501 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code.

13 **SECTION 7.** 341.14 (6r) (b) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

14 341.14 (6r) (b) 1. Upon application to register an automobile, station wagon or
15 motor home, or a motor truck, dual purpose motor home or dual purpose farm truck
16 which has a gross weight of not more than 8,000 pounds, or a farm truck which has
17 a gross weight of not more than 12,000 pounds, by any person who is a resident of
18 this state and a member of an authorized special group, the department shall issue
19 to the person special plates whose colors and design shall indicate that the vehicle
20 is owned by a person who is a member of the applicable special group. The
21 department may not issue any special group plates under par. (f) 53. until 6 months
22 after the department has received information sufficient for the department to
23 determine that any approvals required for use of any logo, trademark, trade name
24 or other commercial symbol designating the professional football team have been
25 obtained.

1 **SECTION 8.** 341.14 (6r) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

2 341.14 **(6r)** (b) 3. An additional fee of \$15 shall be charged for the issuance or
3 reissuance of a plate issued on an annual basis for a special group specified under
4 par. (f) 35. to 47. or 53. An additional fee of \$15 shall be charged for the issuance or
5 reissuance of a plate issued on a biennial basis for a special group specified under par.
6 (f) 35. to 47. or 53. if the plate is issued during the first year of the biennial
7 registration period or \$15 for the issuance or reissuance if the plate is issued during
8 the 2nd year of the biennial registration period.

9 **SECTION 9.** 341.14 (6r) (b) 6. of the statutes is created to read:

10 341.14 **(6r)** (b) 6. An additional fee of \$25 that is in addition to the fee under
11 subd. 3. shall be charged for the issuance or renewal of a plate issued on an annual
12 basis for the special group specified under par. (f) 53. An additional fee of \$50 that
13 is in addition to the fee under subd. 3. shall be charged for the issuance or renewal
14 of a plate issued on the biennial basis for the special group specified under par. (f) 53.
15 if the plate is issued or renewed during the first year of the biennial registration
16 period or \$25 for the issuance or renewal if the plate is issued or renewed during the
17 2nd year of the biennial registration period. To the extent permitted under ch. 71,
18 the fee under this subdivision is deductible as a charitable contribution for purposes
19 of the taxes under ch. 71. All moneys received under this subdivision in excess of the
20 initial costs of data processing for the special group plate under par. (f) 53. or \$35,000,
21 whichever is less, shall be deposited in the general fund and credited as follows:

22 a. An amount equal to the costs of licensing fees under par. (h) shall be credited
23 to the appropriation account under s. 20.395 (5) (cj).

24 b. 1. One-third of the remainder after crediting the appropriation as provided
25 in subd. 6. a. shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.455 (2) (jp).

1 2. Two-thirds of the remainder after crediting the appropriation as provided
2 in subd. 6. a. shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.505 (3) (j).

3 **SECTION 10.** 341.14 (6r) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 341.14 **(6r)** (c) Special group plates shall display the word “Wisconsin”, the
5 name of the applicable authorized special group, a symbol representing the special
6 group, not exceeding one position, and identifying letters or numbers or both, not
7 exceeding 6 positions and not less than one position. The department shall specify
8 the design for special group plates, but the department shall consult the president
9 of the University of Wisconsin system before specifying the design for the special
10 group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47., the Wisconsin sesquicentennial commission
11 before specifying the design for the special group plate under par. (f) 52. ~~and~~, the
12 secretary of natural resources before specifying the design for the special group plate
13 under par. (f) 50. and the chief executive officer of the Green Bay Packers professional
14 football team and an authorized representative of the National Football League
15 before specifying the design for the applicable special group plate under par. (f) 53.
16 Special group plates under par. (f) 50. shall be as similar as possible to regular
17 registration plates in color and design.

18 **SECTION 11.** 341.14 (6r) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act
19 445 and 1997 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

20 341.14 **(6r)** (c) Special group plates shall display the word “Wisconsin”, the
21 name of the applicable authorized special group, a symbol representing the special
22 group, not exceeding one position, and identifying letters or numbers or both, not
23 exceeding 6 positions and not less than one position. The department shall specify
24 the design for special group plates, but the department shall consult the president
25 of the University of Wisconsin System before specifying the design for the special

1 group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47., the secretary of natural resources before
2 specifying the design for the special group plate under par. (f) 50. and the chief
3 executive officer of the Green Bay Packers professional football team and an
4 authorized representative of the National Football League before specifying the
5 design for the applicable special group plate under par. (f) 53. Special group plates
6 under par. (f) 50. shall be as similar as possible to regular registration plates in color
7 and design.

8 **SECTION 12.** 341.14 (6r) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 341.14 (6r) (e) The department shall specify one combination of colors for
10 special group plates for groups or organizations which are not military in nature and
11 not special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47., 50. and 52. The department, after
12 consulting the president of the University of Wisconsin system, shall specify one
13 combination of colors for special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. The department
14 shall specify the word or words comprising the special group name and the symbol
15 to be displayed upon special group plates for a group or organization which is not
16 military in nature after consultation with the chief executive officer in this state of
17 the group or organization, except that the department may not specify the word or
18 words or the symbol for special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. unless the word
19 or words or symbol is approved in writing by the president of the university of
20 Wisconsin system or, with respect to endangered resources, specify the word or words
21 or the symbol for special group plates under par. (f) 50. unless the word or words or
22 symbol is approved in writing by the secretary of natural resources or, with respect
23 to the special group plate under par. (f) 53., specify the word or words or the symbol
24 for the group unless the word or words or the symbol is approved in writing by the
25 chief executive officer of the Green Bay Packers professional football team and an

1 authorized representative of the National Football League or, with respect to
2 commemorating the 150th anniversary of Wisconsin statehood, specify the word or
3 words or the symbol for special group plate under par. (f) 52. unless the word or words
4 or symbol is approved in writing by the Wisconsin sesquicentennial commission. The
5 president may not approve the word or words or symbol for a university specified
6 under par. (f) 35. to 47. unless the chancellor of the university approves in writing
7 the word or words or symbol. The department shall require that the word or words
8 and symbol for a university specified under par. (f) 35. to 47. be a registration decal
9 or tag and affixed to the special group plate and be of the colors for a university
10 specified under par. (f) 35. to 47. that the president of the university of Wisconsin
11 system specifies.

12 **SECTION 13.** 341.14 (6r) (e) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act
13 445 and 1997 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

14 341.14 (6r) (e) The department shall specify one combination of colors for
15 special group plates for groups or organizations which are not military in nature and
16 not special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. and 50. The department, after
17 consulting the president of the University of Wisconsin System, shall specify one
18 combination of colors for special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. The department
19 shall specify the word or words comprising the special group name and the symbol
20 to be displayed upon special group plates for a group or organization which is not
21 military in nature after consultation with the chief executive officer in this state of
22 the group or organization, except that the department may not specify the word or
23 words or the symbol for special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. unless the word
24 or words or symbol is approved in writing by the president of the University of
25 Wisconsin System or, with respect to endangered resources, specify the word or

1 words or the symbol for special group plates under par. (f) 50. unless the word or
2 words or symbol is approved in writing by the secretary of natural resources or, with
3 respect to the special group plate under par. (f) 53., specify the word or words or the
4 symbol for the group unless the word or words or the symbol is approved in writing
5 by the chief executive officer of the Green Bay Packers professional football team and
6 an authorized representative of the National Football League. The president may
7 not approve the word or words or symbol for a university specified under par. (f) 35.
8 to 47. unless the chancellor of the university approves in writing the word or words
9 or symbol. The department shall require that the word or words and symbol for a
10 university specified under par. (f) 35. to 47. be a registration decal or tag and affixed
11 to the special group plate and be of the colors for a university specified under par. (f)
12 35. to 47. that the president of the university of Wisconsin system specifies.

13 **SECTION 14.** 341.14 (6r) (f) 53. of the statutes is created to read:

14 341.14 **(6r)** (f) 53. Persons interested in expressing their support of the Green
15 Bay Packers professional football team.

16 **SECTION 15.** 341.14 (6r) (h) of the statutes is created to read:

17 341.14 **(6r)** (h) From the appropriation under s. 20.395 (5) (cj), the department
18 shall pay reasonable licensing fees relating to the word or words or the symbol on
19 special group plates under par. (f) 53.

20 **SECTION 16. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the first day of the 5th
21 month beginning after publication, except as follows:

22 (1) The repeal and recreation of section 341.14 (6r) (c) and (e) of the statutes
23 takes effect on January 1, 1999.
