

ENROLLED JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to: commending John H. Schroeder.

Whereas, John H. Schroeder served as the 5th chancellor of the University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee; and

Whereas, UW–Milwaukee achieved national recognition as a Carnegie Research II institution under his leadership; and

Whereas, Chancellor Schroeder was in the forefront of legislative activity, advocating on behalf of the university and working closely with legislators to assure state support of UW–Milwaukee and the entire University of Wisconsin System; and
