

**Relating to:** the life and public service of Stan Pelecky.

Whereas, Stan T. Pelecky was born on April 27, 1934, in Milwaukee, and died on March 24, 1997; and

Whereas, after proceeding through the Milwaukee public schools, Mr. Pelecky earned a B.S. degree in mathematics and physics from the University of Wisconsin–Madison; and

Whereas, he served in the U.S. Army Signal Corps and as an attorney for the 32nd Infantry Division; and

Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1962; and

Whereas, during his term in the assembly Mr. Pelecky was a member of the State Affairs Committee; and

Whereas, he also served as Representative Henry Reuss' home secretary; now, therefore, be it
