



1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 28

January 28, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives WASSERMAN, LADWIG, BOYLE, DOBYNS, GOETSCH, MUSSER, OTTE and RILEY. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 36.27 (1) (a); and **to create** 36.27 (1) (b) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** nonresident tuition for undergraduates at the University of
3 Wisconsin-Madison.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System to set the nonresident tuition for undergraduates at the UW-Madison at an amount equal to 175% of their instructional costs. In the 1996-97 academic year, nonresident tuition for undergraduates at the UW-Madison is an amount equal to approximately 124.4% of instructional costs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 36.27 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 36.27 (1) (a) Subject to ~~par.~~ pars. (b) and (c), the board may establish for
6 different classes of students differing tuition and fees incidental to enrollment in
7 educational programs or use of facilities in the system. Except as otherwise provided

1 in this section, the board may charge any student who is not exempted by this section
2 a nonresident tuition. The board may establish special rates of tuition and fees for
3 the extension and summer sessions and such other studies or courses of instruction
4 as the board deems advisable.

5 **SECTION 2.** 36.27 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

6 36.27 (1) (b) The board shall establish nonresident tuition for undergraduates
7 at the University of Wisconsin-Madison at an amount equal to 175% of their
8 instructional costs.

9 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

10 (1) This act takes effect on July 1, 1998.
