



## 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 893

March 10, 1998 - Introduced by Representatives HAHN, SYKORA, URBAN, HANSON, AINSWORTH, OLSEN and GOETSCH, cosponsored by Senators RUDE and ROESSLER. Referred to Committee on Highways and Transportation.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 343.20 (2m) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring the  
2             department of transportation to provide information to applicants for renewal  
3             of drivers' licenses on traffic regulations relating to railroad crossings.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) is required to provide each applicant for renewal of a driver's license with information on child safety restraint systems and, as developed by all organ procurement organizations in cooperation with DOT, information on anatomical donations. DOT must also provide each applicant who is 65 years of age or older with medicare acceptance of assignment information.

This bill requires DOT to also provide each applicant for renewal of a driver's license with information, as developed by DOT in consultation with the state affiliate of Operation Lifesaver, Inc., on traffic regulations relating to railroad crossings.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4             **SECTION 1.** 343.20 (2m) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5             343.20 (2m) The department shall include with the notice that it mails under  
6             sub. (2) information regarding the requirements of s. 347.48 (4); information, as  
7             developed by all organ procurement organizations in cooperation with the

1 department, that promotes anatomical donations and which relates to the  
2 anatomical donation opportunity available under s. 343.175; information, as  
3 developed by the department in consultation with the state affiliate of Operation  
4 Lifesaver, Inc., regarding traffic regulations relating to railroad crossings; and, for  
5 licensees aged 65 years or older, material, as provided by the department, explaining  
6 the voluntary program that is specified in s. 71.55 (10) (b).

7 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

8 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 6th month beginning after  
9 publication.
