



## 1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 102

February 3, 1998 – Introduced by Representatives VRAKAS, NASS, WALKER, LAZICH, GROTHMAN, DUFF, VANDER LOOP, TURNER and BAUMGART, cosponsored by Senators PLACHE, DECKER, ZIEN, FARROW and DARLING. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** recognizing the Council on Worker’s Compensation as it celebrates its  
2             30th anniversary.

3             Whereas, for 30 years the Council on Worker’s Compensation has provided a  
4     forum for Wisconsin employers and employees to collaborate in recommending to the  
5     legislature changes in the Wisconsin worker’s compensation law; and

6             Whereas, the wisdom of the Council on Worker’s Compensation has helped to  
7     mold and refine the Wisconsin worker’s compensation law as necessary to address  
8     emerging issues; and

9             Whereas, the guidance of the Council on Worker’s Compensation has  
10    contributed to the stability of the Wisconsin worker’s compensation program over the  
11    past 30 years and to the recognition that Wisconsin has the finest worker’s  
12    compensation program in the nation; and

13            Whereas, the Council on Worker’s Compensation and the legislature have  
14    enjoyed a cooperative working relationship and exchange of information for the past  
15    30 years; and
