



1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 127

March 25, 1998 - Introduced by Representatives HOVEN, OTTE, GROTHMAN, BAUMGART and LORGE, cosponsored by Senators PANZER and C. POTTER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Curtis McKay.

2 Whereas, Curtis McKay was born on October 10, 1926, in Chicago and died on
3 March 23, 1998, in Sheboygan; and

4 Whereas, he received his undergraduate degree from Grinnell College and a
5 law degree from Northwestern University; and

6 Whereas, he practiced law in Milwaukee and Chicago; and

7 Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1960 and reelected in 1962, 1964
8 and 1966; and

9 Whereas, he served as assistant majority leader for one session and as majority
10 leader for one session; and

11 Whereas, Mr. McKay was a delegate to 3 Republican National Conventions,
12 served on the State Elections Board, was a member of the Bay Lakes Regional
13 Planning Commission and was the legal counsel for the Management Trustees of the
14 Wisconsin State Laborers' Pension and Employment Fund; and
