1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 129

April 28, 1998 - Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES, by request of Representative Spillner and Senator Welch. Referred to Calendar.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Richard Weinke.

2 Whereas, Richard A. Weinke, a peace officer in Sauk County and a member of
3 the United States Marine Reserves, was killed in the line of duty on April 5, 1998;
4 and

5 Whereas, Richard was born at Camp LeJeune, North Carolina on July 1, 1973,
6 and graduated in 1991 from Reedsburg Webb High School; and

7 Whereas, Richard entered the United States Marine Corps in 1992 and was a
8 member of the United States Marine Reserves at the time of his death, holding the
9 rank of sergeant; and

10 Whereas, Richard was a graduate of Madison Area Technical College, where he
11 earned a degree in Police Science in November 1996 and graduated with awards for
12 Top Grade Point Average, Top Shooter and Top Notebook and was elected Sergeant
13 at Arms of his police science class; and
