2 Whereas, Lee E. Grugel was born in Cleveland, Ohio, on October 9, 1940, and
3 died in Madison on October 31, 1996; and

4 Whereas, Mr. Grugel served the state of Wisconsin in several capacities with
5 the University of Wisconsin for many years; and

6 Whereas, he served for 10 years as Dean of the School of Arts and Sciences at
7 the University of Wisconsin–Eau Claire, after spending 12 years as a professor of
8 history at Moorhead State University in Minnesota; and

9 Whereas, he spent 5 years as Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin Centers;

11 Whereas, as Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin Centers, he supported
12 new ways of learning and fostered cooperation in teaching between the centers and
13 the K-12 schools and the Wisconsin Technical Colleges; and

14 Whereas, he enjoyed the respect of his colleagues, as they knew of his dedication
15 to learning and his contagious optimism; and

16 Whereas, Chancellor Grugel continued to build upon the cooperation that goes
