

1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 55

May 20, 1997 – Introduced by Representative SCHNEIDER. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1 **To create** joint rule 15; **relating to:** voting on legislation that increases tax rates

and fees.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution prohibits either house of the legislature from passing a bill increasing the rate of a tax, other than a tax on alcohol or tobacco, or increasing a fee unless the bill is approved by two-thirds of the members elected to the house.

3	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:
4	SECTION 1. Joint rule 15 is created to read:
5	Joint Rule 15. Voting on legislation that increases tax rates and fees.
6	Neither house of the legislature may pass a bill increasing the rate of a tax, other
7	than a tax on alcohol or tobacco, or increasing a fee unless the bill is approved by
8	two-thirds of the members elected to that house.
