



## 1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 96

January 15, 1998 – Introduced by Representatives BOYLE, HUBLER, LINTON and SCHNEIDER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1       **Relating to:** the life and public service of Thomas Murray.

2               Whereas, Thomas Murray was born on May 12, 1938, in Superior and died on  
3       January 6, 1998, in Duluth, Minnesota; and

4               Whereas, he graduated from Superior Central High School in 1957 and earned  
5       a degree in criminal science from the University of Wisconsin–Superior; and

6               Whereas, Mr. Murray served in the U.S. Army, was employed by the Superior  
7       Police Department from 1960 to 1968 and was a Douglas County deputy sheriff from  
8       1968 to 1972; and

9               Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1972 and was reelected 4 times; and

10              Whereas, during his tenure in the assembly Mr. Murray rose to the position of  
11       chair of the transportation committee; and

12              Whereas, he was a member of the Wisconsin Deputy Sheriff's Association and  
13       the Wisconsin Professional Patrolman's Association; now, therefore, be it

14              ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the  
15       Wisconsin legislature commend Thomas Murray's many years of devoted public

1 service, express their grief at his death and extend their condolences to his family  
2 and friends; and, be it further

3 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint  
4 resolution to Mr. Murray's son, Thomas, and his daughter, Shawn.
