



## 1997 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 13

January 20, 1998 – Introduced by Representatives TRAVIS and SCHNEIDER. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1     **Relating to:** helping break the gridlock on 1997 Assembly Bill 421 in the joint  
2             survey committee on retirement systems.

3             Whereas, 1997 Assembly Bill 421, relating to: transferring funds in the fixed  
4     retirement investment trust of the Wisconsin retirement system and increasing the  
5     retirement formula multiplier for certain participating employes in the Wisconsin  
6     retirement system for creditable service earned before January 1, 1998, was referred  
7     to the joint survey committee on retirement systems on June 10, 1997; and

8             Whereas, the members of the joint survey committee and many others have  
9     studied the bill in great detail and the joint survey committee has received the  
10    actuarial opinion on the bill which is required under section 13.50 of the statutes; and

11            Whereas, the joint survey committee is gridlocked on the bill and needs the  
12    assistance of the other members of the assembly to break the gridlock; now, therefore,  
13    be it

14            **Resolved by the assembly, That** for 1997 Assembly Bill 421, the bill and the  
15    actuarial report on the bill are deemed to be the written report and the actuarial

1 opinion required under section 13.50 of the statutes and the submittal of the report  
2 of the actuary to the joint survey committee on retirement systems is deemed to be  
3 the submittal of the report to the chief clerk as required by section 13.50 of the  
4 statutes.
