



## 1997 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 6

June 4, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives TURNER, J. LEHMAN and LADWIG, by request of Racine County Housing Authority. Referred to Calendar.

1       **Relating to:** declaring June 7 to June 14, 1997, Wisconsin Homeownership Week.

2               Whereas, homeownership strengthens families, builds communities and  
3 promotes personal well-being; and

4               Whereas, the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority, the  
5 Division of Housing in the Department of Administration and the Housing Authority  
6 of Racine County, in cooperation with Habitat for Humanity, Heritage Bank  
7 community homebuyers class, the school-to-work program and others, are actively  
8 engaged in efforts to increase homeownership opportunities for the residents of  
9 Wisconsin and the city of Racine through a successful partnership of public, private  
10 and nonprofit organizations; and

11              Whereas, those organizations are actively working with the U.S. Department  
12 of Housing and Urban Development to increase the national homeownership rate to  
13 an all-time high of 67.5% by the end of the year 2000; now, therefore, be it
