



## 1997 SENATE BILL 387

December 30, 1997 - Introduced by Senators ELLIS and ROSENZWEIG. Referred to Committee on Health, Human Services, Aging, Corrections, Veterans and Military Affairs.

1     **AN ACT relating to:** the family practice residency program of the Medical College  
2             of Wisconsin, Inc., and making an appropriation.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law provides state funding to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., for the development and operation of a family practice residency program. This bill provides \$181,900 in fiscal year 1998-99 to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., to fund 2 additional family practice physicians for the residency program. These physicians must be allocated to maximize the number of residents in the family practice residency program.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; Medical College of Wisconsin.**

4             (1) Of the moneys appropriated to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., under  
5             section 20.250 (1) (b) of the statutes, \$181,900 in fiscal year 1998-99 may be expended  
6             only to fund 2 additional family practice physicians for the family practice residency

1 program. The 2 family practice physicians shall be allocated to maximize the  
2 number of family practice residents in the program.

3 **SECTION 2. Appropriation changes; Medical College of Wisconsin.**

4 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation  
5 to the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., under section 20.250 (1) (b) of the statutes,  
6 as affected by the acts of 1997, the dollar amount is increased by \$181,900 for fiscal  
7 year 1998-99 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is  
8 made.
