



1997 SENATE BILL 462

February 18, 1998 - Introduced by Senator RUDE, cosponsored by Representative HAHN. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 115.28 (11) of the statutes; **relating to:** requirements for driver
2 education courses.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law directs the state superintendent of public instruction to approve driver education courses offered by school districts, county children with disabilities education boards and technical college districts and to establish minimum standards for driver education courses offered in private schools. All driver education courses must acquaint each student with the hazards posed by farm machinery and animals on highways and provide instruction in safely dealing with such hazards.

This bill also requires driver education courses to acquaint each student with the hazards posed by railroad grade crossings and to provide instruction in safely dealing with such hazards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
