



1997 SENATE BILL 90

February 19, 1997 - Introduced by Senators BRESKE, GEORGE, ZIEN, SCHULTZ, A. LASEE and FITZGERALD, cosponsored by Representatives HANDRICK, RYBA, VRAKAS, SERATTI and HAHN. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 119.04 (1); and *to create* 118.045 of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 commencement of the fall semester at public schools.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that, beginning in 1998, no public school may commence its school term until after Labor Day.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 118.045 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **118.045 Commencement of school term.** Beginning in 1998, no public
5 school may commence the school term until after Labor Day.
6 **SECTION 2.** 119.04 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
