

**Testimony on Assembly Bill 509  
Before The  
Assembly Committee on Consumer Affairs

Room 417N, State Capitol**

Good Morning, Chairman Otte, and members of the committee. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on Assembly Bill 509 relating to creating a marriage and family therapist's training certificate and the eligibility requirements for taking the examination for a marriage and family therapist or professional counselor certificate. **The Department of Regulation and Licensing and the Examining Board of Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors both SUPPORT AB 509.**

**AB 509** would allow eligible Marriage and Family Therapist applicants the opportunity to use the title "Marriage and Family Therapist", while pursuing supervised clinical marriage and family therapy practice, in fulfillment of the requirements for permanent Marriage and Family Therapist certification. The certificate is for a maximum of 24 months or until the training certificate holder is no longer employed as a marriage and family therapist in a supervised clinical marriage and family therapist practice position or its equivalent. The training certificate cannot be renewed.

**AB 509** would allow Marriage and Family Therapist or Professional Counselor applicants to sit for the examination after successfully completing their degree requirements and before he or she completes the supervised clinical practice requirements.

**AB 509** would allow Marriage and Family Therapists, along with Social Workers and Professional Counselors, to issue training certificates for their applicants.

**We ask for your support and favorable vote on AB 509.** Attached for additional information is a chart which shows the current law, the proposed statutory changes and the reasons.

Again, thank you for the opportunity to comment on this legislation. I would be happy to respond to any questions you may have.

**SUBJECT:** **LRB 3095/2**-relating to creating a marriage and family therapist training certificate and the eligibility requirements for taking the examination for a marriage and family therapist or professional counselor certificate.

LRB 3095/2 draft creates a marriage and family therapists training certificate that is granted by the Marriage and Family Therapist section. The certificate is for a maximum of 24 months or until the training certificate holder is no longer employed as a marriage and family therapist in a supervised clinical marriage and family therapist practice position or its equivalent. The training certificate cannot be renewed.

The proposal allows for a person to take the Marriage and Family Therapy or Professional Counselor's examination before he or she completes the supervised clinical practice requirements if he or she satisfies the application and education requirements.

**Proposal Rationale:**

Would allow eligible Marriage and Family Therapist applicants the opportunity to use the title "Marriage and Family Therapists", while pursuing supervised clinical marriage and family therapy practice, in fulfillment of the requirements for permanent Marriage and Family Therapist certification.

Would allow Marriage and Family Therapists applicants to sit for the examination after successfully completing their degree requirements.

Would allow Professional Counselor applicants to sit for the examination after successfully completing their degree requirements.

Would define the renewal dates for the Social Worker and Marriage and Family Therapists training certificates.


