**BLACK CALLS FOR HEARING ON CABLE TV RATE HIKE**

Representative Spencer Black today called for Assembly hearings to consider additional steps the Legislature could take to protect cable television consumers. Black made his request in the wake of news that TCI Cablevision plans to increase cable rates by an additional 7% on July 1. In a letter to Rep. Cliff Otte, Chair of the Assembly Consumer Affairs Committee, Black said the committee should hold a hearing to explore options for Wisconsin to take action under the recently passed Federal Telecommunications bill.

In his letter, Black, a member of the Assembly Consumer Affairs Committee, noted that "Cable TV is an unregulated monopoly that is once again taking unfair advantage of the consumer. As legislators, we should do whatever we can to provide some measure of relief to the consumer."

According to Black "Cable rates have increased sharply in the last year. Nationwide, cable rates have jumped 10.4 % this year. Most TCI consumers in Wisconsin have seen their rates increase by 18.8% even before the new rate hike." TCI is the nation's largest cable supplier and provides service to much of Wisconsin, including many communities in Dane, Sauk, and La Crosse counties.

Black noted "Only a monopoly could get away with that kind of rate hike."

Black added "Last year, Congress again lifted federal regulation of cable television. Therefore, if the consumer is going to be protected, Wisconsin must do the job. Considering the large boost in cable rates, the state should do whatever it can to rein in the costs to cable consumers. Congress deregulated rates claiming that competition would give the public a choice. 
