

Statement of Need

The Department is proposing to extend the existing fishing tournament permitting rules, which are scheduled to sunset on December 31, 1998 to December 31, 2001. The current tournament permitting rules were originally developed in 1994 with the hopes that a private entity would develop a sanctioning board to administer fishing tournament rules. As yet, statutory authority to establish an external organization to sanction tournaments has not been granted. A private sanctioning body (C.A.S.T.) has formed and is considering sanctioning tournaments as an alternative to the current permitting system. However, the process of transferring authority to administer tournaments has stalled. We have been, and will continue, working with C.A.S.T. on this issue. However, we do not anticipate a solution in the near future and, therefore, propose to extend the existing tournament permitting system.
