CONTRACT LAWS AND REGULATIONS

Recipients of grant award contracts under this program (Contractor, i.e. Grantee) will be subject to the following laws and regulations:

- A. The Contractor will provide the services and required reports in accordance with applicable professional standards.
- B. <u>Subletting or Assignment of.</u> The Contractor will not sublet or assign all or any part of the work under this contract without prior written approval of the Department of Administration, Division of Housing (the Department).
- C. <u>Employment</u>. The Contractor will not engage the services of any person or persons now employed by the State, including any department, authority, commission or board thereof, to provide services relating to this contract without the written consent of the employer of such person or persons and of the Department.
- D. Nondiscrimination in Employment. Chapter 16.765 of the Wisconsin Statutes requires the following provision to be included in every contract executed by agencies of the State. The Contractor agrees to the provisions as stated below:

"In connection with the performance of work under this contract, the contractor agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, religion, color, handicap, sex, physical condition, developmental disability as defined in s.51.01(5), sexual orientation or national origin. This provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruiting or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training including apprenticeship. Except with respect to sexual orientation, the contractor further agrees to take affirmative action to ensure equal employment opportunities. The Contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available for employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the contracting officer setting forth the provisions of the nondiscrimination clause."

- E. <u>Fair Housing</u>. The Contractor agrees to comply with state and federal Fair Housing Laws, specifically Title VIII of the federal Civil Rights Act of 1968 (as amended), and Wis. Stats., s.101.22.
- F. <u>Relocation</u>. The Contractor agrees to comply with the Wisconsin Relocation Law (ss.32.185-32.29, Wisconsin Statutes).
- G. Affirmative Action Plan. All contracts of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or more require the submission of a written affirmative action plan. Contractors with an annual work force of less than twenty-five employees are excluded from this requirement. Within 15 days after the award of the contract, the written affirmative action plan shall be submitted to the State Office of Contract Compliance, Department of Administration.

H. Small Business and Minority-Owned Business. The Contractor shall make positive efforts to utilize small business and minority-owned business sources of supplies and services. Such efforts should allow these sources the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts or subcontracts to be performed utilizing state of federal funds.

- I. <u>Procurement.</u> The Contractor shall conduct all procurement transactions, regardless of whether by sealed bid or by negotiation and without regard to dollar value of the transactions, in a manner that provides maximum open and free competition.
- J. <u>Disclosure</u>. If a state public official (s.19.42,Stats.) or an organization in which a state public official holds at least a 10 percent interest is a party to this agreement, the contract is voidable by the State unless appropriate disclosure is made to the State of Wisconsin Ethics Board.
- K. <u>Legal Relations</u>. (1) The Contractor will at all times comply with and observe all federal and state laws, ordinances, and regulations which are in effect during the period of this contract and which in any manner affect the work or its conduct.
 - (2) In carrying out any provision of this contract or in exercising any power or authority granted to the Contractor thereby, there will be no personal liability upon the Department, it being understood that in such matters the Department acts as agent and representative of the State.
 - (3) The Contractor will indemnify and save harmless the State and all of its officers, agents, and employees for all suits, actions, or claims of any character brought for or on account of any injuries or damages received by any persons or property resulting from the operation of the Contractor, or any of its contractors, in prosecuting work under this contract.
- L. Applicable Law. This contract shall be governed under the laws of the State of Wisconsin.
- M. All material produced under this contract shall remain property of the State. Use of same by the Contractor shall be only with the advance written permission of the Department.
- N. Right to Publish. The Contractor will be allowed to write and have published writings on subjects associated with the work under this contract provided the Contractor has written approval from the Department before publishing such writings.
- O. Conflict of Interest. No persons who is an employee, agent, consultant, officer, or elected or appointed official of the Contractor and who exercises or has exercised any functions or responsibilities with respect to grant-supported activities, or who is in a position to participate in a decision-making process or gain inside information with regard to such activities, may obtain a personal or financial interest or benefit from the activity, or have an interest in any contract, subcontract, or agreement with respect thereto or the proceeds thereunder either for themselves or those with whom they have family or business ties, during their tenure.
- P. Bonding and Insurance. The Contractor will provide either insurance, fidelity, or surety bonds in amounts sufficient, in the opinion of the Department, to safeguard

contract funds and activities undertaken with contract funds and program income expended under this Contract.

The Contractor will establish and maintain in a state or federally insured financial institution an account for the purpose of receiving and disbursing all funds pertaining to this Contract.

- Q. <u>Accounting</u>. The Contractor shall maintain a financial management system which complies with the rules and regulations required by the program funding source and with standards established by the State to assure funds are spent in accordance with law and to assure that accounting records for funds received under the contract award are sufficiently segregated from other contracts, agreements, programs, and/or projects.
- R. Audit Requirements. Government entities, or their assignees, including Non-Profit and For-Profit* assignees, that **expend** \$300,000 or more in a single year from awards which funding originated from Federal Government sources shall comply with the Single Audit Act of 1984 (including the Single Audit Act Amendments of 1996), OMB Circular A-133, and the State Single Audit Guidelines issued by the Department. Audit reports are due to the State within thirty (30) days from issuance of the report, but no later than thirteen (13) months after the end of the audit period.

Non-Profit and For-Profit* entities, or their assignees, that **expend** \$300,000 or more in a single year from awards which funding originated from Federal Government sources shall comply with the Single Audit Act of 1984 (including the Single Audit Act Amendments of 1996) and OMB Circular A-133. In addition, a separate footnote or schedule shall be included listing all awards which funding originated from State Government sources and the total cash expended under each of those awards for the year under audit. Audit reports are due to the state within thirty (30) days from issuance of the report, but no later than thirteen (13) months after the end of the audit period.

Governmental, Non-Profit, and For-Profit entities, or their assignees, that **expend** \$25,000 or more in a single year from awards which funding originated from the State Government sources shall have a certified annual audit performed utilizing Generally Accepted Accounting Principles, Generally Accepted Auditing Standards and Government Auditing Standards. In addition, a separate footnote or schedule shall be included listing all awards which funding originated from State Government sources and the total cash expended under each of those awards for the year under audit. Audit reports are due to the State with thirty (30) days from issuance of the report, but no later than thirteen (13) months after the end of the audit period.

*For-Profit entities: Federal regulations prohibit For-Profit entities from using federal funds to offset the cost of the audit.
