
I write in support of John Husz as chair of the Wisconsin Parole Commission. As you know, responsibility for sentencing in Wisconsin is shared among the legislature, judges, Department of Corrections and Parole Commission. The legislature sets the maximum sentence and for most crimes in Wisconsin has set no minimum. The legislature sets the parole eligibility date and the mandatory release date for virtually all offenses. The judge sets the maximum term to which an offender may be sentenced. The Parole Commission must decide when to release offenders from prison within the parameters set by the legislature.

In effect, the legislature has directed the Parole Commission to make release decisions by the scheme it has created.

John Husz has served as an outstanding chair of the Parole Commission for the past several years. The decisions made by the commission are especially difficult particularly in these times. John Husz has fulfilled his responsibility in a thoughtful and principled way. He has created a very open process, reached out to victims in ways that no parole board ever has and has always considered the welfare of the community and the state foremost in parole decisions. I can think of no other person in the state better qualified and more able to be chair of the Parole Commission than John Husz and I strongly recommend to you that the committee support him as chair of the Parole Commission.

Circumstances do not permit me to be at the hearing on October 22. I am asking that my letter be read and entered into the record. It is what I would say were I able to attend the hearing.

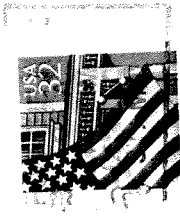

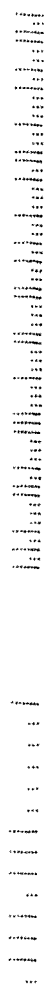
