Expand Presumptive Eligibility for MA (no provision)

Senator Moen: Under current law, certain hospital employees are qualified by DHFS to issue presumptive eligibility cards to pregnant women. As a result of the state's welfare reform initiatives, a number of people who are eligible for MA are not receiving their MA cards and are not receiving the health care services they need. Recommendation: Expand presumptive eligibility for a limited time during W-2 transition so that qualified individuals are able to issue presumptive eligibility cards to all MA eligible individuals. Cost for individuals who are presumed eligible for MA and are not would be covered by providers. Those presumed eligible who are eligible for MA are already funded through the MA budget.
